	I,II	MANGO PARTY Children will be asked to bring different varieties of mangoes. One child will bring one mango. The teacher can ask only a few kids to get. The teacher will talk about different varieties in the class. Children will recognize the shape, smell and taste of different mangoes. Later there will be a mango party in the class. Children will be offered cut mangoes on paper plates brought by them. A song on mangoes will be uploaded on the smartboard.
