1. I am red in colour. I have small petals. I have green leaves. Who am I?

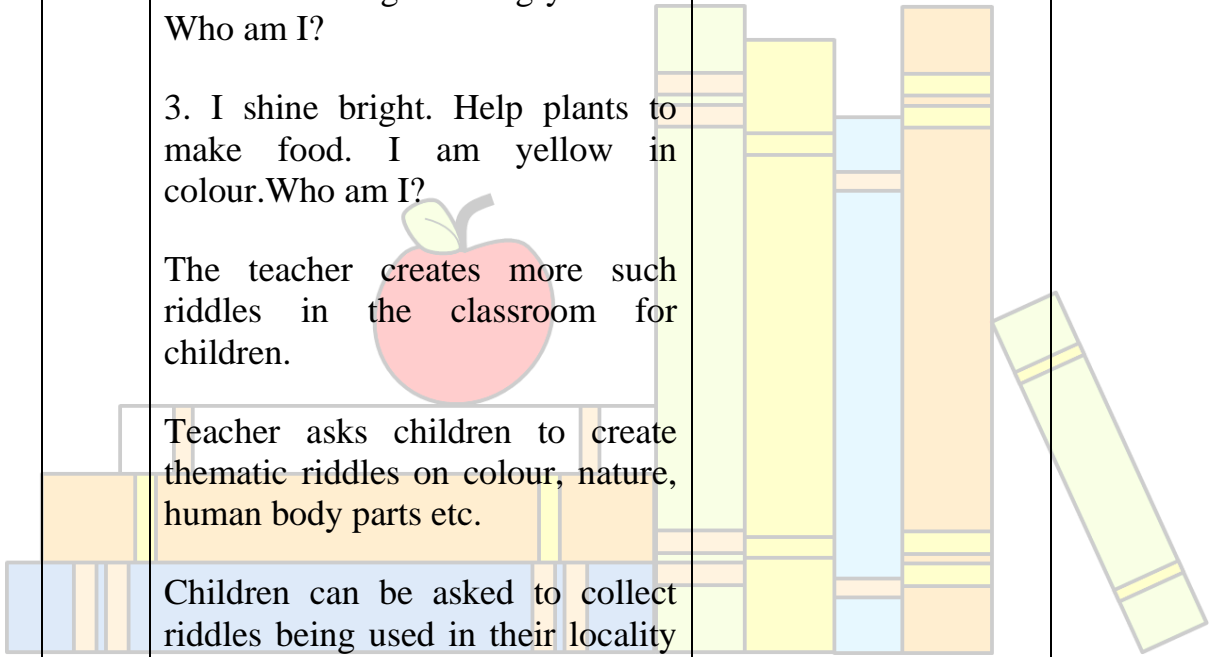
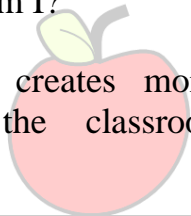
2. I am white in colour. I can fly but don't have wings. I bring you rain. Who am I?
