### 12<sup>th</sup> November 2020 (Thursday): Children’s Day Assembly and Diwali Celebrations

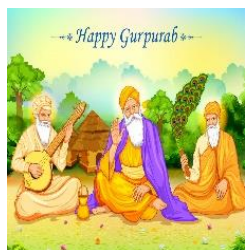
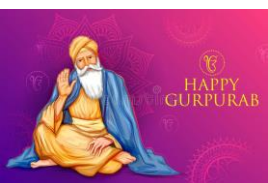
