**Please send tricolor food in the tiffin and tricolour balloons (inflated) for decorating the class.**



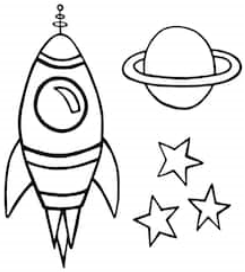
