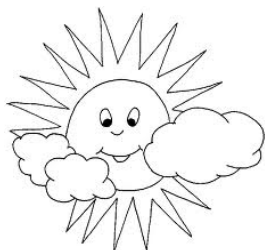




1<sup>st</sup>December, 2019.
