Dear Parent,



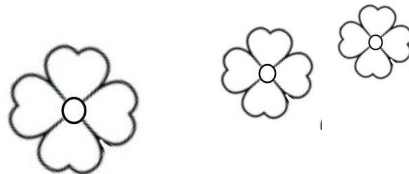


