




7th September, 2014 (Friday)-Teacher's Day Assembly

Providing exposure to cultural diversity in our country through food.

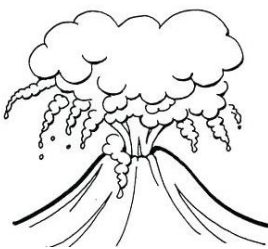
**27th September, 2018

Children will be given clues about animals and birds and they will have to identify the same based on the clues. The children will also be told about photosynthesis and the parts of a plant.



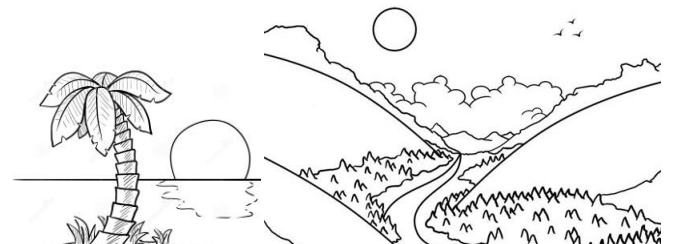
Increasing the general knowledge about animal, birds and plants.
