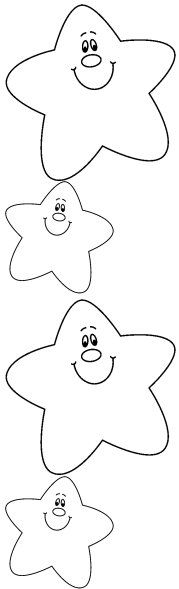


We know you and your child are excited about beginning a new year in the school and we are all geared up to make school time pleasant and exciting for your child and you.

**Friday, 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2018- Earth Day Assembly**





