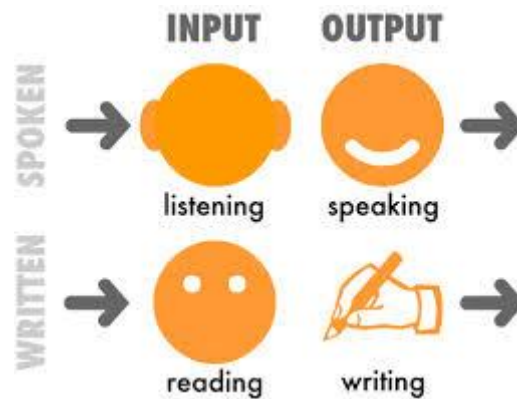


ENGLISH
